


1. Give nine rules for the use of capital letters

Ten Small Towns In Northern California Where Everyone Knows Your Name

Camino, Dunsmuir, Volcano, Sutter Creek. **Pescadero**, Ferndale, Oroville, Marysville, Nevada City, and **Mount Hermon**, (Originally called "Tuxedo Junction" from 1841 - 1906. Five women got together and started the Mount Hermon Association in 1906, naming this tiny town after the peak in the Holy Land. On dedication day, over 1400 folks gathered to hear a speech by Dr. Rueben A. Torrey, President and founder of the Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, Illinois.)

Roofing Project

The cost to roof the church, as quoted by *Michael's Roofing* is \$41,000 plus \$80/hour for any dry rot work. Estimated cost potentially is \$50,000. Congregational giving last month totaled almost \$3,000. Envelopes for donations to repair the roof are in the pews.

The team recommended to Session that \$20,000 be borrowed from Trivent to be paid back at \$300/month starting June 2016. On Sunday, May 22, the church budget was presented to the congregation.
